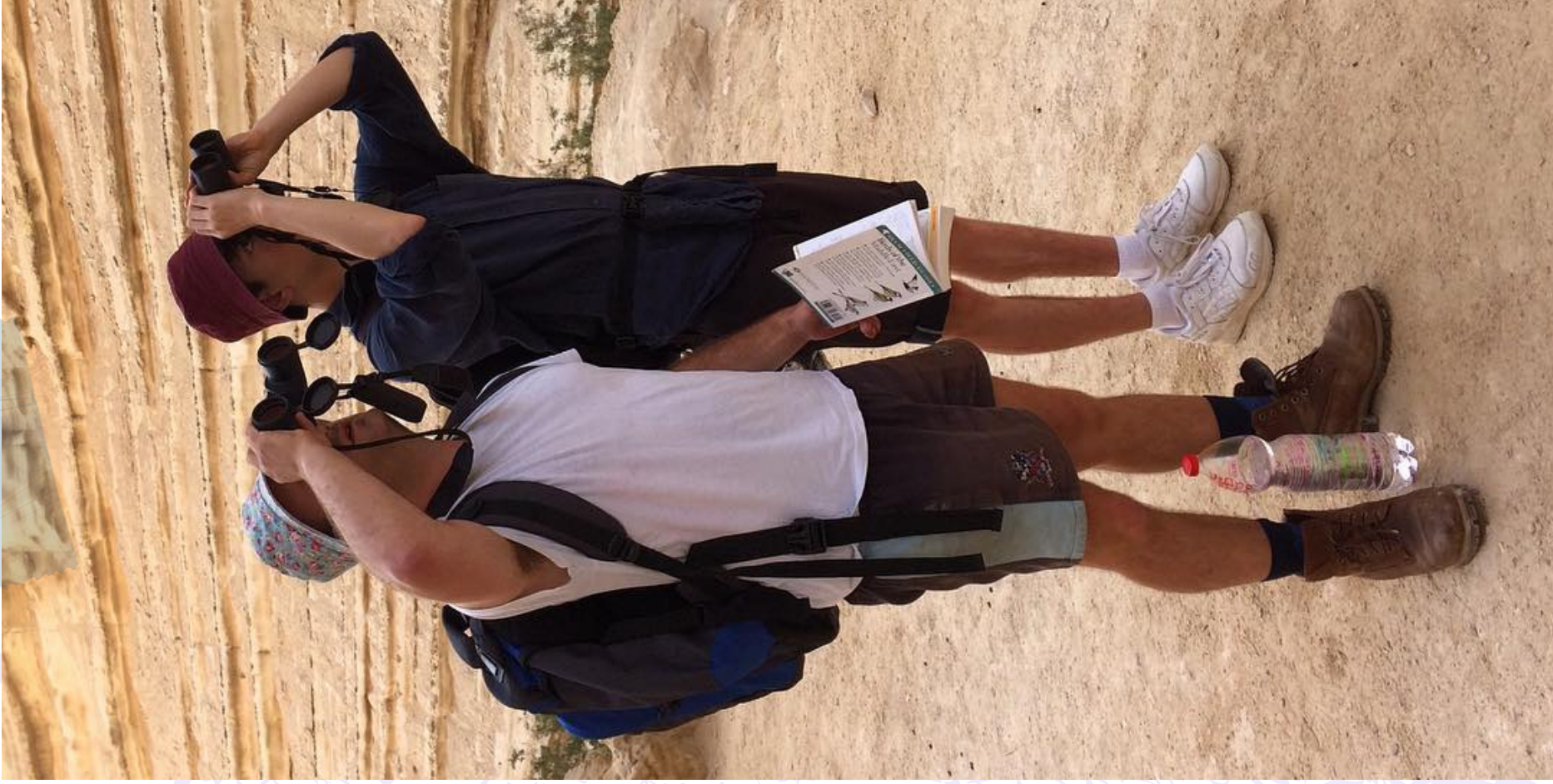

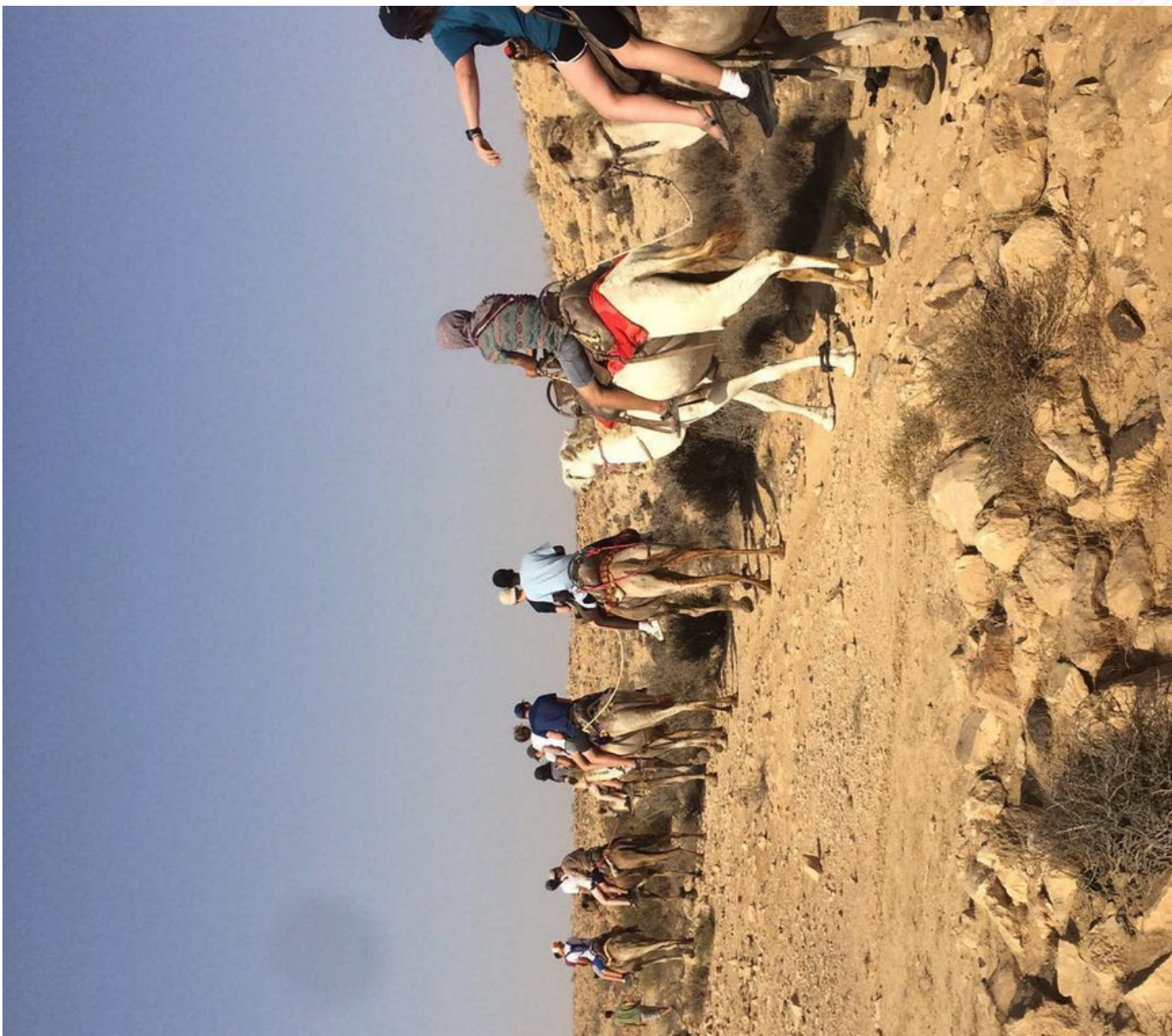

The South

Discover the same beauty which captured Ben Gurion's heart by going on breath-taking tiyulim (hikes), experiencing the ins-and-outs of kibbutz life and seeing for yourself the communities that have grown in the region.

Tel Aviv – The Old New Land

Financial Assistance

UJIA and Noam are committed to financial inclusion to ensure that all young people in the British Jewish community can participate in the programme. Families unable to meet the full cost of the programme can apply for means-tested financial assistance, provided by both UJIA and Noam, by ticking the appropriate box on the Initial Application Form. You will then be sent a Financial Assistance application form by Noam. The UJIA Bursary Fund Committee guarantees complete confidentiality and anonymity throughout the process

Security and Itinerary

The safety, security and wellbeing of all our participants is, and always has been, our primary concern.

Noam Israel Tour is planned according to the security directive of the relevant security forces in Israel, who check the itinerary regularly and advise on changes which may need to be made.

Extra Information

Please note that at any time up until departure, you may incur the cost of an additional fuel surcharge and airport tax by the airline. UJIA Israel Experience will have to pass any increased charges on to the participants and their families, as per their Terms and Conditions.

Application Process



All forms for Israel Tour will be online only.
On receipt of the online initial application form by the movement and deposit of £350*, you will receive an email which will contain:

- a) The applicant's unique link to their full application
- b) GP Form and Letter to be completed
- c) Important Information and Terms and Conditions booklet
- d) Other information concerning your Israel Tour

All deposits (and initial applications) need to be received by Friday 10th February 2023

All application and medical forms need to be completed by Monday 27th February 2023

Your place on Israel Tour will be confirmed upon receipt of your completed application and medical forms. Please note: All places on Israel Tour are only confirmed once full payment has been received. If anything changes relating to your medical information before the start of Israel Tour, it is your responsibility to inform us in writing before the start of the programme. Tour participants are to attend a Tour orientation day in the lead up to Tour.

Noam reserves the right to change the content of the programme at short notice.

*a smaller deposit amount is possible for those requesting.

Payment and Cancellation

Full payment must be received, or a payment plan agreed with Noam, by Monday 1st May 2023, otherwise we will not be able to accept you on Noam Israel Tour.

If an Applicant or Parent/Guardian (if Applicant is under 18) wishes to cancel their place on a Programme he or she must contact in writing the Youth Movement/Organisation they booked through.

An Applicant or Parent/Guardian (if Applicant is under 18) who cancels his or her place prior to the deposit payment deadline (as defined in the Youth Movement/Organisation literature) will be entitled to a refund less the Administration Fee.

Any Participant or Parent/Guardian (if applicant is under 18) who cancels after the deadline will be entitled to a refund according to the following schedule:

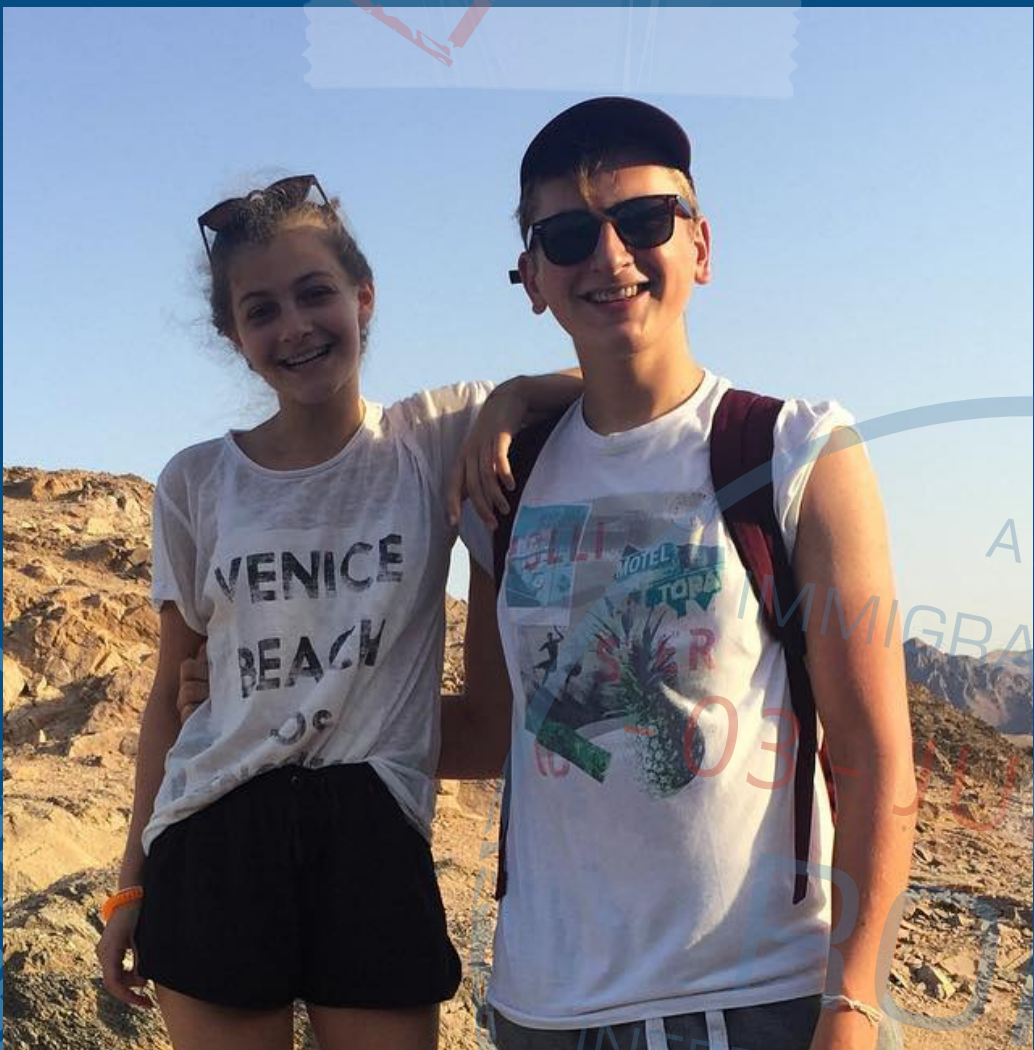
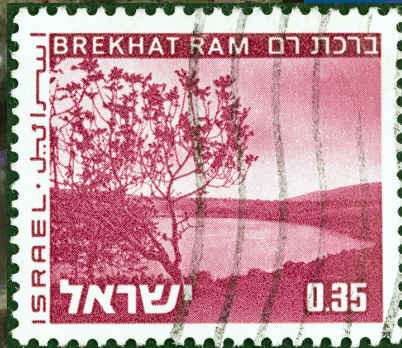
- 61 days or longer prior to departure date: 100% of monies paid less deposit and the Administration Fee;
- From 31–60 days prior to departure date: 50% of monies paid less deposit and the Administration Fee;
- From 15–30 days prior to departure date: 20% of monies paid less deposit and the Administration Fee;
- From 1–14 days prior to departure date: no monies refunded.

For the avoidance of doubt, if a Participant or Parent/Guardian (if Applicant is under 18) cancels their place for medical reasons, the cancellation policy will apply and it is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian to file an insurance claim.

Please note: if a place on Israel Tour is cancelled, a re-application will only be accepted by the Youth Movement/Organisation at their sole discretion (although application to a different Youth Movement/Organisation is permitted).

If a cancellation is due to the illness or death of the Applicant or his or her immediate family and provided that the Applicant or Parent/Guardian (if Applicant is under 18) provides the Youth Movement/Organisation with a valid medical or death certificate or independent verification of the exceptional circumstances (if requested) then the Youth Movement/Organisation shall process a claim for the remaining money (after the terms in 1.3 have been applied) with the insurance company. This will be in accordance with the insurance cover outlined in the Important Information Document.

If the Participant fails to check in for their flight from the UK, and have not contacted the Youth Movement/Organisation to explain why circumstances have delayed their outward travel and to obtain approval for a change of date for outward travel, then JAFI retains the right to cancel any other arrangements booked with JAFI; the Participant will therefore be unable to use any connecting or return flights to the UK. No refund will be made for any unused arrangements in these circumstances.
