Job Description for Noam Movement Worker

Role Title: Noam Movement Worker

Responsible to: Noam Director and Mazkir/a

Period: August 13th 2025- August 19th 2026

Compensation: £23,000 - £25,000 (dependent on position and experience)

Summary of the Role: Lead on all of Noam's projects throughout the year including our Hadracha training program, summer programs and events. Develop youth programming in Masorti communities. Work with a diverse range of people from reception aged chanichim to leaders in communities. Also, in part responsible for creative visioning of the ideological direction of the movement.

Residential Events

- Organise all elements of our Winter Camp, Veida, and Shabbatonim from logistics, advertising, recruitment, content, welfare, safeguarding, and education.
- Empower other Noam members during events, developing the future leadership of the movement.
- Monthly summer camp meetings to coordinate the running and organisation of camp.
- Recruitment and training of all summer camp staff and participants.

Community Work

- Collaborate with Masorti communities to strengthen their youth programmes and build a vibrant Noam cohort.
- Develop engaging programmes for High Holidays and chagim, supporting and mentoring community teens to lead youth services.

Israel Programming

- Liaise with UJIA Israel Experience in the development of Noam Israel Tour.
- Work with Marom Olami and participants in running the Drachim programme.
- Recruit for the subsequent Drachim programme.
- Run further Israel activities in communities and events throughout the year.

Hadracha Training & Chinuch

- Producing and running our two year leadership training course Meltam/Masa
- Recruit participants and teachers for the program and the following relevant summer program (tour/staff on Machane)
- Inspire and prepare participants to be leaders on Machane.
- Work as part of NNLS' Haderech programme to train mentors and create Hadracha opportunities.
- Engage in educational opportunities individually and as part of the Mazkirut.
- Occasionally go into schools and communities to run educational sessions.

External Organisations

- Liaise with other partner organisations, including UK Taskforce, Rene Cassin, Keshet UK, Board Of Deputies, Zionist Federation, UJIA.
- Maintaining a Noam presence in the Jewish Press.

Communications

- Use Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Newsletter, the website etc. to promote Noam and the work of the movement.
- Create content that increase interest and interaction both among members and parents.
- Find innovative ways to excite and engage members online and elsewhere.
- Communicate with members.

Fundraising

- Take part in at least one major fundraising campaign as a group.
- This includes grant writing/reporting, and creating fundraising events such as the Supper Quiz and summer fundraiser.

Reporting Line

The Noam Movement worker will have a weekly 1-1 with the Noam Mazkir/a to discuss projects and their own development.

They will attend weekly Noam Mazkirut meetings and fortnightly Masorti team meetings.
